Hopi people sincerely carry on a tradition that is dedicated to all peoples. This gifting is from a place of respect acknowledging the challenges of living in remote NE Arizona far from economic resources of urban America.

You are invited to make a monetary donation, mail or bring new gifts and food. We are not taking used clothing and used items for the holidays.



Food: pinto beans, shortening, peanut butter, canned meats, honey, cocoa, nuts, flour, coffee, tea bags, canned yams, powdered/canned milk, oatmeal—good solid staple foods. We also take produce, meat, eggs.
Toiletries: Lotion, tooth brushes, toothpaste, deodorant, soap, sham poo and conditioner, hair brushes and combs, manicure kits, hair ties, etc.
Children's gifts: sport items such as basketballs, soccer balls, footballs, baseballs, frisbees, kites; art and school supplies, learning games
New Household items: sets of bowls, pots, pans, dish & bath towels
New Clothing: all ages, sizes: socks, sweaters, sweat suits, etc.
Elders: Blankets, sheets, towels, aprons, sweaters, sweatsuits, toiletries
Gift Cards for Wal-Mart, Bashas, Safeway.
