

The Arizona Department of Transportation has started an improvement project through the switchbacks of SR 89A in the Coconino National Forest.

Access to Sedona, campgrounds, and area businesses to remain open during construction.

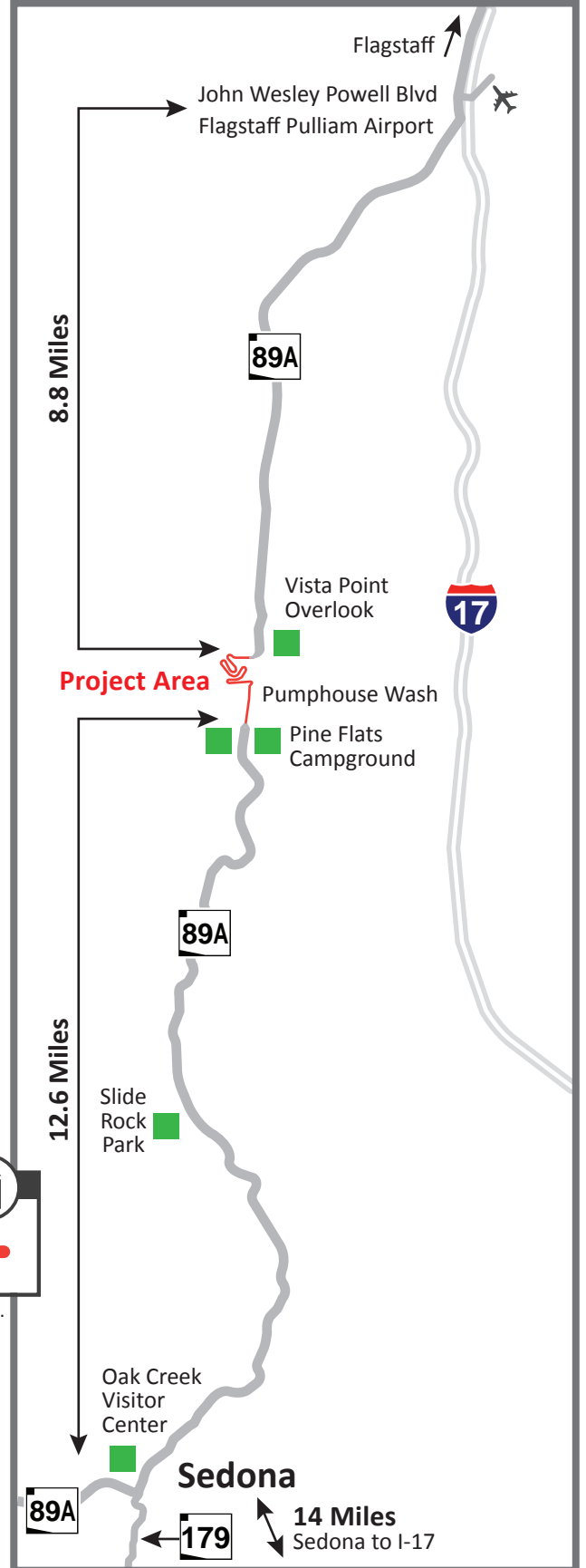
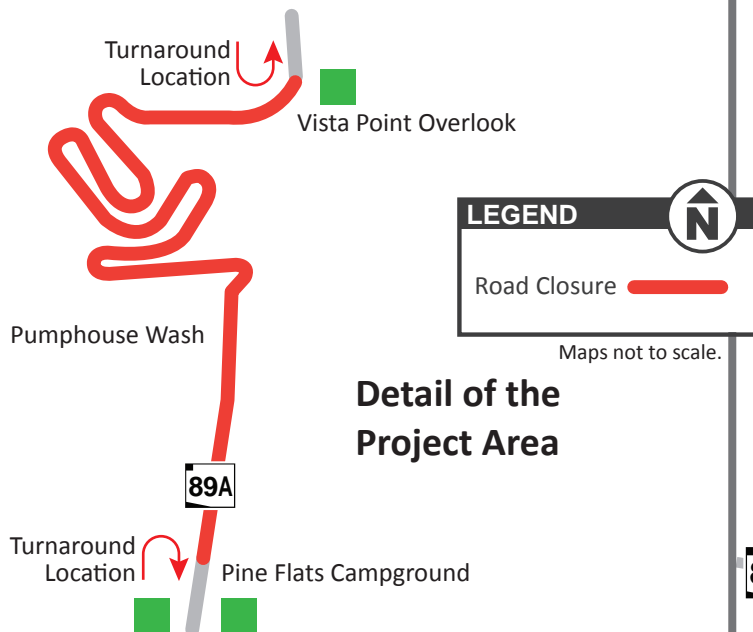
In order to complete the project, including milling and paving, and rockfall mitigation, in the safest and timeliest manner, there will be a full closure of SR 89A in the switchbacks between May 27–July 2, 2014.

Access to all campgrounds and businesses in Oak Creek Canyon will be maintained at all times, as well as the city of Sedona.

The detour around the closure will be via I-17 and SR 179. Access will be maintained at all times for emergency vehicles.

During the full closure there will be construction crews working around the clock to ensure the work is completed as quick as possible. Access will be maintained at all times to the Pine Flats Campground and Vista Point Overlook once the full closure is in place at each location early morning Tuesday, May 27.

Uniformed DPS officers will be stationed at both north and south ends of the project limits to enforce roadway closure.
