Currently there is a proposal for revising the APS opt out policies scheduled for this December 12th. (E-01345A-13-0069) – Application for Approval of Automated Meter Opt-Out Service Schedule 17 with Notice and Opportunity to be Heard. This proposal was sent out for public review and comment by Steve Olea, Director of the AZCC Utilities Division, only last week.

I agree with the motion already made that any vote on this docket be postponed to a future evidentiary hearing to allow full consideration by the affected public who are customers of APS. In my opinion, it is an improper administrative practice to request review and comment six business days prior to AZCC policy decision-making on a proposed rulemaking that is as significant as this one is.

As an intervener in Docket E-00000C-11-0328, I am making a motion that the docket be closed, and that you issue a procedural order that all wireless "smart" meters in Arizona be removed ASAP. As you may know, the Arizona Department of Health Services recently issued a study in which they did not find wireless AMI "smart" meters to be safe. Utilities using such meters now violate A.R.S. 40-361.B and A.R.S. 40-321.A.

If you are unable or unwilling to issue such a procedural order, I make an alternative motion that the above docket take the form of an evidentiary hearing because I think it is very important that all parties be under oath when testifying.
